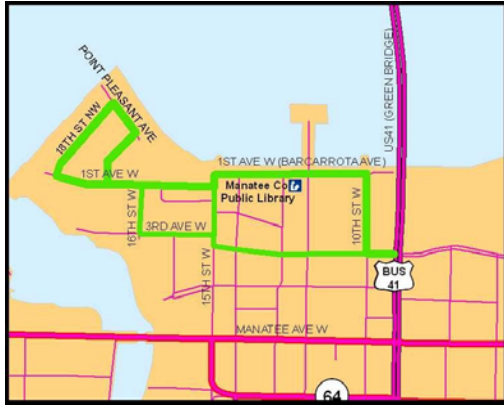

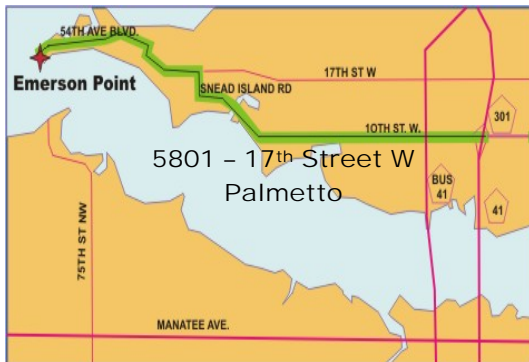

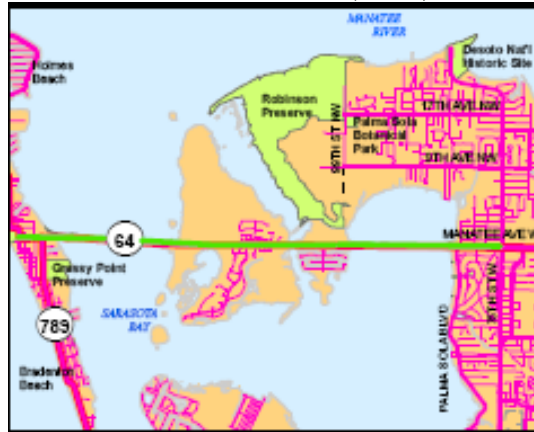
PAVED and OFF-ROAD

MANATEE AVE (SR 64)



Manatee Avenue (State Route 64) from Bradenton to Anna Maria Island and Bradenton Beach has a designated bike lane and is also a Florida Scenic Highway.
